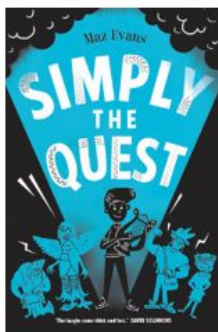
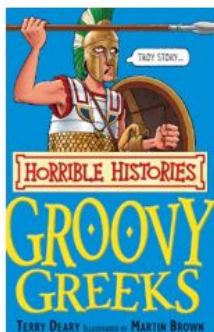
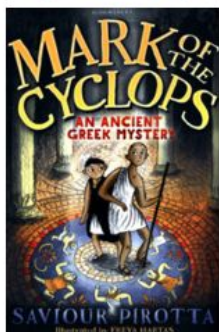
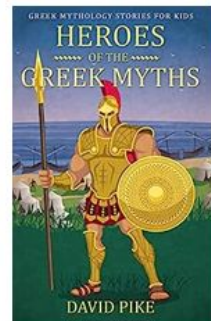
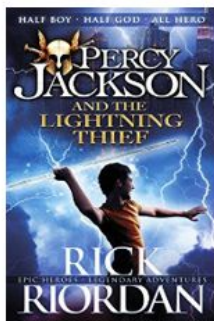
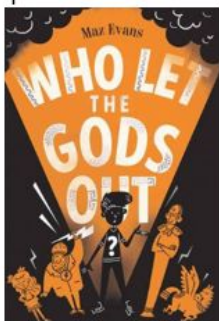
Meet your new teacher!

Ancient Greece Project Ideas:

- Find out about the Greek alphabet and present your findings in an exciting way.
- Create a picture of an imaginary Greek God. Make sure your poster is eye-catching and full of facts and information. Try to think of a symbol for your God.
- Find out what life was like for children in Ancient Greece.
- Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games.
- Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield.
- Cook some Greek food or a meal. Write up the recipes. Can you include a photo of your creation too?
- Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to maths? What is Pythagoras' theory?
- Design and make a mask which could be used in an ancient Greek play.
- Read an Ancient Greek myth, then write your own modern day mythical story.
